Dear Resident of the Villages of Northgate Crossing:

This is a courtesy letter to notify you that Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America ("NGPL") will be replacing a portion of the 30" pipeline which runs through Reserve B, in the Villages of Northgate Crossing, situated in Harris County, TX. Recent testing of the pipeline revealed an anomaly under I-45, requiring the replacement of that portion of the pipeline, for safe operation of the pipeline. There should be no disturbance to your property, as all work will be contained within NGPL's existing pipeline right of way. The project is anticipated to start on or about October 29, 2009 and be complete on or about the week of November 16, 2009, weather permitting.

During the construction period our personnel will be informed to drive slowly, and watch for your children and keep your streets as clean as practicable. In addition, security personnel may be on hand, if requested, by your community and temporary fencing can be installed, where streets are open, onto the pipeline right of way; and the personnel will be instructed to have "Johnny Cans" available, for their crew, during construction. All work will be in conformance with all safety mandates.

For safety reasons, we ask that you please remain off the pipeline easement (Reserve B), during this construction period.
