Summary of Events

ASSAULT – 6

1. 24000 Pinecreek Point Ln – Nightshift – Deputy was dispatched to the location in reference to a Family Assault between mother and daughter. Victim was pushed out of the way. Victim did not feel pain and did not want to pursue charges. No charges were filed. Report was filed.

2. 800 Shirefield Ct – Nightshift – Deputies were dispatched to a family disturbance involving husband and wife. Husband pulled out his gun and pointed it against wife's cheek. Both slapped each other. ADA accepted charges for Aggravate Assault with a Deadly Weapon. Offender was placed under arrest and transported to JPC for processing. Arrest Report was filed.

3. 1000 Lamson Ct – Nightshift – Deputy was dispatched to an accidental injury type call. Charges were not accepted due to the victim being non credible in her statements and no eyewitnesses/ video footage of incident to corroborate victim statements. Report was filed.

4. 23800 North FWY – Dayshift – Deputies were dispatched to an unknown type of disturbance.

Deputy made contact with female who stated her baby's father attacked her. Both parties had superficial injuries. ADA declined charges for assault due to the credibility of the victim. Report was filed.

5. 900 Morley Park Ln – Evening Shift – Deputies were dispatched in reference to a family weapon disturbance. Victim stated step-father attempted to run him over with the vehicle. Step-father denied the allegations. Mother refused to pursue charges. ADA declined charges. Report was filed.

Reporting party stated her boyfriend got physical with her two different times throughout the night. Suspect was gone prior to deputy's arrival. ADA accepted charges for Assault Family Violence. BURGLARY OF HABITATION – 2

1. 22500 Spring Link Ct – Dayshift – Deputy was dispatched to a burglary of habitation and learned unknown suspect(s) entered victim's residence while away on vacation. There were no signs of forced entry nor damage to property. TV's and a Playstation were stolen. There was no video, no witnesses, and no evidence to assist in this case. Report was filed.
