Summary of Events

NORTHGATE CROSSING STATS

BURGLARY OF MOTOR VEHICLE – 7

1000 Maple Run Dr. – Dayshift – Unit responded to the location and learned that an unknown suspect had entered into the complainant's un-locked vehicle and stole their laptop. The property was entered into NCIC system under stolen. There was no camera footage of the incident.

1000 Orié Ct. – Dayshift – Unit was dispatched to a BMV at location and learned that an unknown suspect(s) entered the complainant's vehicle by breaking the back left window. A pistol and miscellaneous clothes were solen. There were no suspects or serial number information available at the time of the report.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD. – Nightshift – Unit was dispatched to the hotel located in the contract due to a third-party bystander advising a vehicle in the parking lot had a broken window and appeared to have been broken into. During the investigation it was discovered that the

suspects stole the complainant's work laptop and other valuables worth approximately \$8,000. No camera footage nor serial numbers provided.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Dayshift - Deputy was dispatched to location in reference to a BMV. Unknown suspect(s) broke the back left window to the vehicle and stole several items. No suspects, no video, no witnesses.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Nightshift – Supervisor responded to a BMV where victim could no stay on location due to having to leave. Victim was advised to come back when he was available so that the report could be updated with a list of all items stolen and serial numbers.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Nightshift – Unit responded to the hotel regarding a burglary of a motor vehicle. During the investigation it was discovered that an unknown suspect entered into the complainant's vehicle by breaking the passenger window and stole an I-Phone and I-Pad. Serial numbers were provided, and the items were entered as stolen with NIC numbers. There was no surveillance footage available at this time.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Dayshift – Unit responded to the location and learned that an unknown suspect caused approximately \$3,000 worth of damage to the complainant's vehicle and stole work tools. Clerk could not review video footage.

THEFT OF VEHICLE – 2

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD. – Evening shift – Unit was dispatched to the apartment complex in reference to a stolen vehicle. It was discovered that an unknown subject(s) stole a vehicle from the parking garage, vehicle was entered into NCIC as stolen.

22300 North Freeway – Dayshift – Unit arrived at the location regarding a stolen vehicle. It was discovered that the complainant had parked their vehicle on the property due to malfunctions and when the owner returned it was gone. Camera footage was reviewed and it revealed that a red in color pickup truck hooked up to the abandoned vehicle and hauled it off. The vehicle was entered into NCIC as stolen.

THEFT OTHER – 3

700 Manchester Trail. – Evening shift – Unit was dispatched to the location regarding a theft. Investigation revealed that a known suspect had damaged the complainant's door and stolen property from her residence. The items were recovered by responding unit. The District Attorney's Office was advised of the incident and declined charges due to the suspect living at the residence and items being returned.

1100 Northgate Springs DR. – Dayshift - Deputy was dispatched to the location for a theft of a tailgate, which occurred in the early morning hours. There are no suspects, no video, and no witnesses. The tailgate cost approximately \$1,200.

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD. – Dayshift - Deputy was dispatched to a theft of a catalytic converter that occurred in the early morning hours. 1 out of 3 suspects was identified from the video surveillance and the registration from the suspect vehicle. The Harris County District Attorney's Office was advised of the incident and accepted charges for felony theft.

ROBBERY -1

23700 Springwoods Village PKWY. – Evening Shift – Units responded to the apartment complex regarding an aggravated robbery. During the investigation, it was discovered that two unknown

suspects had shot the victim four times in his shoulder and legs during an attempted robbery where the victim was selling THC vape pens. The victim was transported to a nearby hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. During the investigation, detectives were able to identify the two suspects and charges were filed.

SEXUAL ASSAULT – 1

706 Silver Cliff – Nightshift – Unit responded to a nearby hospital where it was learned a young juvenile made an outcry of abuse from her sibling. No charges due to both being minors and CPS was contacted who took over the investigation.

FAMILY DISTURBANCE – 2

22300 Spring Crossing DR. – Evening Shift – Units were dispatched to the location regarding a family disturbance. Investigation revealed that two adult siblings were involved in a physical altercation that led to one of them being taken to the hospital for a possible head injury. The complainant appeared to be intoxicated and could not explain what happened. Deputies gathered statements from witnesses and then contacted the Harris County District Attorney's Office however charges were declined.

23700 Springwoods Village PKWY. – Nightshift – Units were dispatched to the location regarding a family disturbance. Investigation revealed that the two parties were involved in a verbal argument, and no assault had occurred. Parties were separated for the night.

RUNAWAY – 1

23100 Burcan Ct – Nightshift – Units responded to the location regarding the recovery of a runaway. Investigation revealed that a known juvenile had been staying at a residence and the homeowner believed they were a runaway. Units attempted to contact the juveniles mother but was unsuccessful so she was transported to juvenile detention center in good health.

OTHER - 12

23700 Springwoods Village PKWY. – Evening shift – Consumer was making outcries therefore they were detained and transported to a nearby hospital and a EDO was conducted.

22900 Benton Point DR. – Evening shift – Units responded to the HCCO 4 substation where it was learned an unknown subject used their SNAP card without their consent. Totaling approximately \$800.

700 Northridge Terrace LN. Dayshift – It was learned that an unknown person opened an account without the complainant's permission.

23600 Northgate Crossing BLVD. Evening shift - Unit was dispatched to a credit/debit card abuse report. Upon arrival, unit contacted the reportee, who advised that fraudulent charges had been made on his credit card without his consent.

800 Hannock Glen – Dayshift - Reporting party stated that he had not seen his firearm since he moved out of the residence back on 06/25/2025. He stated it was left under a mattress that he sold with the house however the family living in the residence now claims they never seen/found a firearm. The firearm was entered into TCIC as stolen.

23300 Triple Spur LN – Dayshift - Deputy was dispatched to location for a death investigation. Investigation revealed that the victim had passed away and there were no signs of foul play. The

Harris County Medical Examiner's Office responded to the location and cleared the scene with decedent.

22300 North Freeway – Dayshift – Unit responded to the location due to a vehicle that was parked blocking the entry/exit. Upon the deputy's arrival, the driver was observed to be asleep behind the wheel. A probable cause search was conducted and unprescribed pills were found in the vehicle. The Harris County District Attorney's Office was advised of the incident and accepted charges on the female driver for driving under the influence. The vehicle was towed from the roadway.

23300 Wolfs Crossing – dayshift – Reporting party stated he had not seen his child for about a week due to a relationship ending. Reportee wanted to document the incident, to provide for civil court.

23800 North Freeway – Units conducted a welfare check on a vehicle that was illegally parked. The occupant in the driver side was slumped over and upon making contact showed multiple signs of being intoxicated. However, due to vehicle being off and keys not in the ignition, charges for DWI were declined and the occupant left the location with a known friend.
