#### Summary of Events

Northgate Crossing December Stats

Assault – 3

1000 Maple Run DR. – Evening Shift – Unit was dispatched to a residence in reference to a physical altercation between mother and daughter. The argument started over chores then escalated to pushing and shoving. Unit arrived and separated the parties, both stated they did not feel pain, nor did either party want to file charges. DA was contacted and charges were declined. Report was generated and completed for the incident.

800 Flanners CT. – Dayshift – Units responded to a residence known for family disturbance, this call reports that the woman found her husband in a lie and caused a disturbance. After investigation and allegations of assault, units did not find any bruising or markings that added with the assault claims. DA was contacted but only referred to family violence. Parties were separated. Supplement was done, and pictures were taken to add to this report.

22400 Lieren LN. – Dayshift – Units respond to a residence where a married couple fighting over a cell phone. One party of the couple was suspicious of unfaithfulness, she wanted to look through her partners' phone when a tussle was insinuated. Scratches were observed on both parties but neither wanted to pursue charges. DA was contacted and charges were declined. Report was completed for this incident.

BMV – 2

23800 North Freeway – Evening shift – Unit responded to a hotel where a vehicle parked in the

parking lot unoccupied was broken into. Unit was not specific on what was stolen, and cameras were reviewed to find a white in color Jeep with the LP visible, however unit was not specific on who, what, where the vehicle came back to. Report was completed for this incident.

26300 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Dayshift – Unknown person(s) made forced entry to reporting party's work vehicle stealing hundreds of dollars' worth of power tools. There are no video footage of the incident at the apartment complex. The tools were not entered due to no serial numbers provided.

#### Criminal Mischief – 2

22300 North Freeway – Dayshift – Manager of business reported two storage doors appeared damaged due to forced entry. No video footage at this time. No items reported stolen at this time. No later reports of items missing, therefore the call stayed criminal mischief.

23800 North Freeway – Evening shift – Unit responded to this hotel, victim's vehicle was reported broken into, Victim stated that there were no items taken from the vehicle, camera footage showed a white in color Jeep pull next to the vehicle and an unknown person was responsible for the damage. No information for that Jeep was provided for this report.

#### Family Disturbance – 2

23500 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Nightshift – Domestic disturbance was reported at this location, husband and wife reported going through a divorce, the couple started a verbal argument where female began to break items in the residence. Police arrived and it was advised there can be no charges filed for breaking items that belong to that person. Male stated he was in fear for his life that female would hurt him in his sleep. The female could not be forced out of her residence, units left the scene and no reported disturbance was called again at this location.

22700 Northgate Ridge DR. - Dayshift – Unit responded to this residence in reference to a weapons disturbance, when units arrived the call was later found to be less serious. The reporting party was identified, but as she was telling her story it was not found credible to the responding officer. The reported crime did not add to any of what was stated, the DA was contacted but no charges were filed, female party is from out of state and wished to go back. Female was criminally trespassed from property and taken to a bus stop near the location.

#### Theft – 2

26300 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Dayshift - Reporting party stated their amazon package was delivered, and somehow was taken from where it was placed. No camera footage. Victim contacted tenants that live in the surrounding area but no luck on findings of the package.

22300 North Freeway – Evening shift - Reporting party wished to file a report on behalf of their tools being stolen from a storage facility. Victim stated that over \$3,000 worth of tools were missing from the storage unit. No camera footage was explained nor added to this report.

#### Burglary Habitation – 1

800 Northcastle LN. – Dayshift - Victim wished to file a report after a male suspect entered his residence without permission. Suspect pulled on victim's shirt and victim ran suspect off premises. Ring camera showed suspect tried to enter the front door, then seen walking to the back, but video footage did not capture the footage. Units were not able to locate the suspect. No injuries were reported.

Other – 9

23500 Northgate Crossing – Evening shift – Unit responded to a department complex where unit was informed reportee's son made an outcry of suicide, because of personal reasons. Unit detained the male and he was transported to Ben Taub Hospital on a EDO.

26300 Northgate Crossing BLVD – Dayshift - Reporting party stated that his signature was forged to cash a check worth \$4,500. Unknown as to who the person(s) responsible. Victim stated that he needed a report to provide to his bank.

23700 Springwoods Village PKWY – Nightshift – Unit responded to a minor accident at location which then led to a DWI type call. Driver was unconscious when unit arrived and when they were conscious, they displayed multiple signs of intoxication. Suspect was then placed in custody and transported to JPC. Vehicle was towed from location.

700 far Pines DR. – Dayshift – Unit arrived and learned that victim stated her old credit card had been used from someone else without their permission. \$217 was reported charged from a clothing business known as The Gap. Addresses were provided but it is not reported that the unit followed up on this incident. Report was just completed.

22900 Thistlebury LN. – Nightshift – Reporting wished to report her bother as missing, she stated that the male was last seen a month ago. According to units report the victim's vehicle was hit in the 290 area. Apparently he is known to be in that area. Also he has had been reported missing before in the past. Male was entered in the NCIC/TCIC system as missing according to the report. No further updates on the male's whereabouts.

1100 Crossgate BLVD. – Evening shift – Child custody issue between a couple wanting their child. Report was documented for court violation purposes. No disturbance occurred or reported.

700 Becketts Crossing LN. – Nightshift – Units responded to a residence where it was found that a young male stated he wanted to kill himself for personal reasons. Male reportedly taken approximately 20 painkillers. The male was transported to a nearby hospital where unit filed an EDO due to his outcry and actions.

700 Far Pines DR. – Dayshift – Victim wished to file a report that her soon to be ex-husband came to her residence through the garage, and taken her work phone without her permission. No assault of threats were made. Male just came and took her phone, no other incident occurred.

28400 Hardy Toll RD. – Dayshift – Unit responded to the business and met with a contract worker who made a civil agreement to do work around the business. When the person who made the agreement to pay did not respond reporting wished for a report so he can take to his lawyer.
